

 <p>Franklin County Public Health</p>	<p>Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) Joe Mazzola, Health Commissioner</p> <p>As the lead agency for the Community Cessation Initiative grant, FCPH has the responsibility for organizing a county-wide collaborative effort to assess existing tobacco cessation assets and services in the community, identifying gaps in the delivery of services or outreach of services then adopting evidence-based interventions aimed specifically at disparate populations, but available for all Franklin County tobacco users.</p>
